The Obverse which is common to all the coins in this collection, features a design based on the Armorial Bearings of Seychelles.

5 Rupees depicts the Coco-de-Mer Palm.

1 Rupee depicts the Triton Conch Shell, which grows to one foot long. When the tip is removed it can be used as a trumpet by fishermen announcing their arrival on shore.

25 Cents depicts the very rare Black Parrot, found only in the Vale de Mai Nature Reserve of Praslin.

5 Cents depicts the Cassava Plant, one of the main food crops on the Islands during the nineteenth century. Cassava is still grown today on small family farms.

10 Cents depicts the Yellow Fin Tuna found in the warm waters off the Seychelles, which is of great economic importance.

1 Cent depicts the Crabe Bleue which can be found on the reefs around the Seychelles. It is the best known edible crab of the Islands.
