Commemorative Coins of The First Emperor of China
 —Emperor Chin Shihuang
 Issued by Democratic Republic of Congo



Emperor Chin Shihuang (259-210 B.C.) had Ying as his surname and Zheng as his given name. He had a great and deep influence upon China's 2,000-year-old feudal society.

By 246 B.C., He named to the throne of the Chin at age of 13, and took the helm of the states eight years later. Since then, he abolished the enfeoffment system and adopted the prefecture and county system. He standardized legal codes, written language, currencies and measures. To protect against harassment by the Han aristocrats, he ordered the Great Wall be built. All these measures played an active role in eliminating the cause of the state of separation and division and strengthening the unification of the whole country as well as promotion the development of economy and culture.

By 221 B.C., after 10 year's war, he had annexed the six rival principalities of Qi, Chu, Yan, Han, Zhao and Wei, and established the first centralization multicultural empire in China's history. Ying Zheng styled himself emperor and named himself "Shihuang Di", the first emperor in China.

Remark: the void of the facial design of Emperor Chin Shihuang

The indistinct pattern of Emperor Chin Shihuang's face demonstrates the special inventive mind of the designer of this coin. The designer considered Chin Dynasty as a "non-face era" due to its long history over 2,000 years ago.

Even in Chin era, it is impossible to reveal Emperor Chin Shihuang's true face behind the pearl blinds of the crown to common people, because of his supreme position. The image of Emperor Chin Shihuang is not a common secular figure, but a historical outline leaving to the legend. That's why the designer left blank of the face side of Emperor Chin Shihuang on this coin.
